NEEDHAM TOURNAMENT 2011 Rules of the Competition

PLAYER EQUIPMENT:

NO CASTS - EVER - NO MATTER WHAT!!

Teams have been sent notice-NO CASTS. Some have withdrawn due to this policy-as they had player(s) with hard casts that they insisted play. No deal. There will be hell to pay if any Ref allows one and others relate that to the refuseniks,

It is a safety issue. Send Refs home who compromise safety & our policy--Youth event-do not ignore NMDT safety policy.
LONG Standing.

Shirts, socks, shoes, shorts, shin guards = only allowed equipment. NO casts, no hard billed baseball, faulty cleats, bandanas, caps for keepers or anyone else. Prior injuries should keep players off field until they are healthy. Wrapping is not healed. No exposed sharp metal. No jewelry. Medical alert devices / religious type, may be taped to body or inside of uniform. Color conflict home team (named 1st schedule) must change/or put on scrimmage vests.

Nothing unsafe to players themselves or opponents is allowed. Any odd/unusual equipment must -must be sanctioned ahead of time, with written USSF approval. Err-make mistake on safety's side every time, Referee's decision on game is final. Other games, other Referees, other days in this event or any event- means NOT that an unsafe condition is by fiat safe or valid. There is no precedent. **Youth=SAFETY FIRST.**

TIME

Games will be 2- 30 minute halves. 5 minutes for ½ time. No OT. Referees must start on time. .Inspect players quickly. Check that goals are anchored. Do not check player passes .Get coin toss done ahead of scheduled time. Find Captains along touchline. No need for center circle ceremony. Get it done while players are warming up or waiting for prior game to end. No Referee speeches that no one remembers -say "Enjoy the game."
Teams must be ready at scheduled time or it is a forfeit (1-0).

Example; Game is scheduled for 9:00. One team shows up at 9:10. The next game must go off scheduled at 10:10 AM The 9:00 game will not be played at all. Late team forfeits. If they are not there, we do not wait for them,.

. **Never add time or stop clock. NEVER.**

In event of injury or weather interruption, the clock still runs.

Example; An injury occurs 15 minutes into game. EMT's are called. Player is not moved. The clock runs to half time. Allow 5 minutes for ½ time break. Then kick off for 2nd half. Game ends 1 hour + 5 minutes after it began, Example weather stops game in 2nd half, after 10 minutes of half played. Clock runs. After 20 minutes more the game is over.

The next scheduled game on that field goes off on time. There are too many times slots-it is impossibly impractical to wait. Games that complete a half , are considered official.

SUBSTITUTIONS.

Subject to permission & Referee beckoning onto the field Referee: subs are allowed; **unlimited & free: goal kicks, after goal, halftime, injury (clock is NOT stopped)**

If offensive team chooses to sub-own throw-in, only then- may the defense do so.

If players receive a caution(yellow card).they may be substituted for-**not mandatory.**

LIGHTNING & WEATHER Play is stopped for first visible signs of lightning—regardless of distance away. The clock will still run. Play is not resumed until 30 minutes after last lighting seen. If game stops at 2:50 PM-safe to play again at 5:20PM, the teams scheduled for 5:20 will begin play.
5-10EdR

8 v 8(as apposed to 6 v 6) has offside and Goalkeeper may punt ball into attacking zone. Goal kicks may be sent over 1/2 way line, into attacking zone as well.
